New Custody and Control Form

The new Custody and Control Form contains all the same data as the form you have been using, but makes room for some innovative and helpful changes.




The CCF Section contains all donor demographic information and chain of custody affidavits along with corresponding signature blocks.

A **Unique Form ID Number** links the CCF, the donor receipt and security seals to a specific, individual form.

The **Quest Client Requisition Number** identifies the account number for the client requestiong the test and the sample ID number used for tracking and results reporting.




The **Donor Receipt** has a pre-printed barcode that is forensically linkable to its CCF counterpart. It also contains information pertinent to the donor.




Security Seals are compatible with urine, oral fluid, hair and blood specimen collections.
